# Week Twenty-eight

### <u>Joshua 3</u>

Key Verse: v.7

Key Word: "dry ground"

**X-Ref:** *Exodus* 14:16

Paraphrase: Joshua prepares Israel to cross the Jordan.

## Examining the Text:

- 1) What was the signal that it was time to cross the Jordan? When you see the ark of the covenant being carried by the Levitical Priesthood v.3
- 2) What sign does Joshua say will be shown to Israel to prove that God was among them and would drive out the inhabitants of the land? When the soles of the priest's feet touched the water, the water would stop and stand in a heap vs.10-13.
- 3) On what and where did Israel cross the Jordan? On dry ground across from Jericho vs. 16-17.

# <u>Joshua 4</u>

Key Verse: v.14

**Key Word:** *"exalted"* – v.14

**X-Ref:** *Exodus* 14:31; *Psalm* 89:13

**Paraphrase:** The setting of 12 stones to remind Israel how God brought them through the Jordan on dry ground. **Examining the Text:** 

- 1) A man from each tribe was commanded to take a stone from the Jordan river and stack them on the other side as a reminder. What about this command would lead us to conclude that these were sizable stones? *They were told to carry them on their shoulders v.5.*
- 2) Which tribes passed over the Jordan first? *Reuben, Gad, and the half tribe of Manasseh v.12.*
- 3) What was the purpose of the 12 stones? To remind Israel and future generations about how God brought Israel through the Jordan on dry ground vs.21-24.

# <u>Joshua 5</u>

Key Verse: v.7, v.7, v.15

**Key Word:** "Circumcision" – v.2.

X-Ref: Genesis 17:3; Exodus 3:5; Exodus 16:35

Paraphrase: God commands Joshua to circumcise all the males in the camp.

## Examining the Text:

- 1) Whose "hearts melted" when they heard that the Lord dried up the Jordan for Israel to cross on dry ground? *The kings of the Amorites and the kings of the Canaanites* v.1.
- 2) Who did Joshua circumcise at Gibeath-haaraloth and why weren't they circumcised already? *These were the male descendants of the people who came out of Egypt. They were not circumcised along the way vs.2-7.*
- 3) On what day of the month did God cease from giving Israel manna from heaven and why? *The* 15<sup>th</sup> day because now they would eat the produce of the land. vs.10-12.

## <u>Joshua 6</u>

Key Verse: v.20 Key Word: "wall" – v.20. X-Ref: Hebrews 11:30-31; James 2:25; Joshua 7:1 Paraphrase: Instructions for conquering Jericho.

# Examining the Text:

- List God's instructions for taking Jericho. A) Men of war once around the city 6 days. B) Seven priests each with a trumpet of ram's horn going before the ark. C) On the 7<sup>th</sup> day mark 7 times around and the priests blowing the horns while the people shout at the end of the 7 times around.
- 2) What did Joshua tell the people they could not do until he told them to? *Shout or speak where they could be heard vs.10.*
- 3) What did Joshua say would happen if someone kept for themselves those things devoted to destruction? "Trouble upon Israel" v.18.

# <u>Joshua 7</u>

Key Verse: vs.10-12 Key Word: "get up" – vs.10 & 13. X-Ref: Joshua 6:18

#### Week Twenty-eight

#### **Daily Bible Study - Answers**

**Paraphrase:** Israel loses the battle at Ai. God tells Joshua that Israel has sinned. Achan is put to death for his sin. **Examining the Text:** 

- 1) Why did the hearts of the people of Israel "melt"? Because they lost a battle with Ai and about 36 men died vs.2-5.
- 2) Who does Joshua sound like in verse 7? Those who died in the wilderness often complained and wished they had never left Egypt.
- 3) In Joshua 1:5, God promised that no one would be able to stand before Israel. Now in 7:12, He points out that Israel cannot stand before their enemies because they had transgressed the covenant. What command does God now give to Joshua? "Get up!" And "consecrate yourselves" vs.10-15.

#### <u>Joshua 8</u>

Key Verse: v.26; v.35 Key Word: "ambush" – v.2 X-Ref: John 4:20

## Paraphrase: The second battle of Ai.

# Examining the Text:

- 1) What type of strategy did God command Joshua to use against Ai? An ambush -v.2.
- 2) What was the signal for the second group to enter the city? When Joshua raised his javelin toward the city of Ai. vs.18-18.
- 3) How did the King of Ai die? Joshua hung him on a tree v.29.
- 4) What did Joshua do after the battle? *He built an altar. Then he wrote the law on stones. Finally, He read all the law that Moses wrote to the people vs.30-35.*

# <u>Joshua 9</u>

Key Verse: v.14

Key Word: "covenant" – v.15.

X-Ref: 2Samuel 21:2

Paraphrase: Gibeon deceives Israel into making a covenant to spare their lives.

## Examining the Text:

- While Most of the nations gathered to battle against Israel, what did the Gibeonites do? They deceived Israel into feeling sorry for them. They made them believe that they were from a distant country and not inhabitants of the land. They begged them to make a covenant with them and let them be their servants – vs.3-15.
- 2) How could they have avoided this mistake? *They should have spoken to God first v.14*.
- 3) How did Joshua deal with the Gibeonites? *He kept them alive but made them cutters of wood and drawers of water* v.27.
